

## **Kamloops Counterbalance Forklift Training**

Kamloops Counterbalance Forklift Training - Counterbalance Forklift Training courses are always in high demand. The Counterbalance forklift is a forklift which is made with a weight which counters the balance, equally spreading the weight of the load across the forklift arms. Counterbalance forklifts are designed so the weight behind the center of gravity is counterbalanced by the weight on the lift. The load is projected out from the front of the machinery so it is visible to the driver of the forklift. This particular type of forklift truck must only be utilized on level, stable ground or on a prepared surface.

Training is necessary for forklift operators to know the correct way to distribute the load equally across the forklift arms. Trainees would know how to lower and raise the load vertically and how to tilt the mast of the forklift both forwards and backwards between 5 and 15 degrees. Trainees would learn the RTITB standards needed for safe forklift operation. People training would also become familiar with the types of attachments for the forklift arms.

Kinds of Counterbalance Forklifts:

### **Walkie Pallet Trucks**

Walkie Pallet Truck is a counterbalance forklift suitable for getting into areas that are small and cramped. This particular lift is highly maneuverable and capable of accessing practically any tight spot.

### **Walkie Stackers**

The Walkie Stacker is another forklift which differs slightly from the Walkie Pallet truck in terms of its lift height. This machinery is designed to access tighter areas and has extra lift capabilities for high stacking. Neither of the Walkie line of lifts could be ridden. The operator has to walk behind them.

### **Rider Pallet Trucks**

The Rider Pallet Truck is made so the driver can ride it. These riding lifts are great for dock unloading and loading.

### **Wave Work Assist Vehicle**

The Wave Work Assist Vehicle is a counterbalance forklift meant to reach great heights of up to 17 feet.

### **Sit Down Counter Balanced Trucks**

The Sit-down Counterbalance Forklift is built in three-wheel and four-wheel forklift designs. These tough and durable trucks are designed to be ridden.
