Kamloops Loader Training - Loader Training Programs - Be Safe Always - Any individual who wants to operate a lift truck has to take a Loader Training program to become a certified forklift truck operator. There are several ways to obtain forklift training. Programs are provided through workforce training agencies, company forklift certification programs, and approved video and online programs. The cost can be minimal (or free) when offered through employment agencies or by occupational safety officers on job sites.

In most countries, lift truck operators are needed to be over the age of 18 years old. Local industry bodies together with federal and local authorities could approve the Loader Training courses. They require that operators obtain forklift certification prior to utilizing a forklift machinery. A certificate is valid for four years in most areas. Businesses that hire employees to drive forklift trucks can face serious liability issues if operators fail to keep this certificate up to date.

Untrained forklift operators can lead to property damage and serious injury due to improper use of the machine. Training consists of the proper loading and driving methods. Employees should pass a written exam to be able to be certified. A company would normally designate a supervisor to provide hands-on training to new employees. A certified supervisor must have extensive training in forklift safety and be trained as a trainer.
