Forklift Training Tips

It is important that all workplaces utilizing forklifts have the checklist below or one equivalent on the premises. If all of the safety rules are being followed, each of these questions must be answered with a "yes". A "no" to whichever question indicates a procedural weakness that may cause damage to machinery, accident or injury.

- 1) Is the forklift operating area separated from pedestrian traffic?
- 2) Is pedestrian access to travel areas of the forklift restricted by barriers?
- 3) The walkways for pedestrians are well-marked?
- 4) Are "forklift in operation" signs clearly visible?
- 5) Are mirrors for drivers and pedestrians provided at blind spots?
- 6) Are changes to daily lift truck schedules communicated to all affected employees?
- 7) The forklift tires being used are suitable for all operating surfaces?
- 8) Is the seatbelt being used?
- 9) Is the seat in good condition?
- 10) Is a regular forklift maintenance schedule followed?
- 11) Are yearly inspections of the forklift being carried out?
- 12) Is the type of forklift right for the tasks?
- 13) Is there a readable load chart on the forklift?
- 14) Do all operators understand how to read the load chart?
- 15) Does the chart list the safe capacity for various uses and attachments?
- 16) Are the warning devices on the lift truck working correctly?
- 17) The speed operating control device is secured properly?
- 18) Is overhead cage fitted properly on the forklift?
- 19) Do the operators of the lift truck have certifications to use the machinery?
- 20) Are speed limits and warning signs being observed?
- 21) Are lift truck operators up to date on training for all types of lift trucks being utilized?
- 22) Forklift operators know their duties to report the damage to the machine and other forklift incidences?
- 23) Prior to the machinery being operated, the pre-test checklist is being reviewed daily?
