The limits and abilities of the machine are taught, along with necessary operating measures, pre-operation inspections and ways of warning other employees that a forklift is in the work area.

Lessons include the placement of the trailer tires and chock blocks, the arrangement of pallets to spread out the load properly, and inspections needed before driving into a trailer at a dock location. Courses likewise include Material Safety Data Sheet (or MSDS) training. Though not related directly to the operation of a lift truck, MSDS training is essential in the event that an operator damages a container containing toxic materials, or notices a leaking container. MSDS sheets list the products, their effects on people and correct methods of handling spills.
